 - Rank projects and programs






Anticipated Benefits of the Imperial IRWMP

- State funding eligibility










Water Forum adopted & prioritized goals -


- 1. Increase water supply

- Ag, urban and energy water use efficiency






Priority 2 – Protect Water Quality

 - Urban Runoff Management








Priority 3 – Environmental Protection and Enhancement


- Ecosystem & Water Related

 - Define needs, develop project concepts, establish guidelines for project/program development




- Coordinate Land Use/Water Supply (Apportionment)

Imperial IRWMP Timeline


- Region Acceptance Process CDWR approval Sept 2009

- 10th Water Forum meeting April 2011





- Prop 84 Implementation Grant Application Summer 2012


